Greetings,

I wanted to make you aware that Huron County's second Household Hazardous Waste Collection date has changed. Earlier this spring, we gave you the following information on the fall collection:

"The second collection is set for Wednesday, September 8 from 2 - 6 p.m. More information on this collection will come as we get closer to the date. These collections are designed to help homeowners properly discard hazardous waste they may not know what to do with. This is NOT designed for commercial or industrial waste."

The NEW collection date for the fall collection is now Tuesday, September 7. It will still be held from 2-6 p.m. for anyone interested in attending. Participants must contact the MSU Extension office before September 7 to find out the exact location of the collection and to leave a contact number just in case things change again before that date.



One of the most popular questions we get regarding HHW items is: Do we accept Latex Paint? The answer to that is no. Latex is a water-based paint and can be dried out safely.

- Toxic (poisonous), flammable, caustic (causes burns), or chemically reactive materials. Some examples: oil-based paint, drain cleaners, pool chemicals, alkaline batteries, pesticides, antifreeze.

Unacceptable items: Latex Paint, Explosives, flares, weapons, radioactive waste, trash, tires, yard waste, industrial and/or commercially-generated waste, large appliances (refrigerators, stoves, dishwashers, etc) 55 gallon waste containers.
