SummerTax Payments

Summer 2025 tax payments are due by **September 15, 2025**. Payments by mail are encouraged and should be sent to:

Please include, with payment, the yellow tax bill in its entirety if you would like a receipt mailed back to you. If paying by **check**, you may drop off your payment in the secure drop box located in the entrance of the hall labeled “for tax payments”. A receipt will be mailed to you, if you include the yellow tax bill in its entirety.

If paying with CASH please call 586.292.4872 for an appointment. You will need to have the exact amount.

In person tax payments can be made at the Lake Township Hall **on September 15, 2025 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.**

Recycling limit—two (2) green recycling containers.

There is no need to sort recycling; however we ask that you only recycle clean household trash such as plastic containers, #1 and #2 plastic jugs and bottles, aluminum cans, glass jars and bottles, magazines, junk mail, newspaper, cardboard and paperboard.

No foam packaging, styrofoam, plastic bags, bubble wrap, coated paperboard, milk/juice/water cartons, paper coffee cups and lids, plastic plant containers, etc. A more complete list is on our website and available at the Transfer Station upon request.

Leaves, grass and tree trimmings are accepted at the Transfer Station during regular hours at no charge and also on Saturdays from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. during the months of May and November, only.
