EMERALD ASH BORER

The Michigan Department of Agriculture has issued a quarantine for 13 counties in Southeastern Michigan in an effort to control the spread of the Emerald Ash Borer. It is illegal to move ash trees or ash products from any of these 13 counties, which include Lapeer, St. Clair, Genes Shiawassee, Ingham, Livingston, Oakland Macomb, Jackson, Washtenaw, Wayne Lenawee and Monroe. It is also illegal to transport ANY TYPE OF FIREWOOD from these areas. Your cooperation
