Services 101.... Who does what ?

Fire services for Lake Township are provided by the Caseville Area Fire Protection Association (CAFPA). Kelly Smith and Marty Maurer are Lake Township's representatives on the CAFPA Board. Marty was appointed last December to fill Len Pilato's position. Len resigned last December due to health reasons after serving on the CAFPA Board since December 2000.

The Fire Chief wants to remind residents the fire trucks are quite large, similar to a large furniture delivery truck. Make sure access to your home/ property is capable of accommodating their trucks year round in case of emergency.

Ambulance service for Lake Township is through the Village of Elkton Ambulance Service. Rhonda Jennings, Don Vandeberghe and Bill Simmons are First Responders in Lake Township.

For trash service, you have the option of contracting with a private trash company for curbside pickup or taking your trash, recycling and yard waste to our Transfer Station located on Sand Road just east of Champagne Road. Our Attendant, Dave Ferris, is there to assist you. Fees are nominal for trash. Recycling and yard waste are free.
