Summer—June 2021

Gypsy Moth— Aerial spraying was done the first week of June and we are hearing that it has helped. We would appreciate residents keeping us informed late summer or early fall as to whether there are any areas of infestation. Send an email to supervisor@laketownship.net or call the Township Hall.

Elections— The County has scheduled an election for August 3, 2021 for the renewal of two county millages—older citizens services and veterans' affairs. Absentee ballot applications were mailed out the second week of June. If you have not received an application and wish to vote by absentee ballot, please send an email to clerk@laketownship.net.

**Recycling**—We have made some changes at the Transfer Station this summer to our recycling program by limiting the days recyclables are accepted to Wednesdays and Saturdays only and limiting the quantity allowed to two green recycling containers or their equivalent. During the summer months our two recycling containers end up overfilled and our attendant has had to shut down the recycling. We are not able to obtain larger dumpsters or an additional dumpster. While we appreciate the enthusiasm for this program, we also find it to be abused with items that should not be put in the recycle containers. Please review the recycling handouts available at the Transfer Station or on our website and if you have any questions about items, please check with our attendant. We appreciate everyone's cooperation if we are to keep this program viable for our residents.

Permits— We would like to remind people that we have adopted a new Zoning Ordinance and three (3) General Ordinances pertaining to junk control, abandoned vehicles and abandoned structures, which are available for viewing on our website. Please contact the Zoning Administrator prior to starting any project that might require approval such as fencing, retaining walls, sheds, garages, additions, and new homes. Also, building permits are required for reroofs and window replacements.

Township Meetings—We will be holding our meetings during the summer months at the Sleeper State Park Outdoor Center in order to maintain social distancing while holding in-person meetings. The Outdoor Center is located just south of the State Park Headquarters on State Park Road. Please check our website for posted meetings and agendas.

**Burning**— If you are burning leaves, a permit is required. Call 989.856.9198 for a burning permit and follow recorded instructions. Burning of leaves is allowed as long as weather conditions are acceptable, but burning of trash is not allowed pursuant to General Ordinance No: 2005—01. At the current time our area is in a moderate drought, so be aware that burning bans could be in effect.

Short Term Rentals—Due to complaints arising from short term rentals of single family dwellings, we have formed an advisory committee to review and recommend whether these uses should be regulated and to what degree. Let us know what you think ...info@laketownship.net.
