If paying by check, you may drop off your payment in the secure drop box located in the entrance of the hall for tax payments by check, only. A receipt will be mailed to you, if you include the yellow tax bill in its entirety. There will be a \$20.00 fee due to Lake Township on returned checks. If paying with CASH please call 586.292.4872 for an appointment. You will need to have the exact amount. **Burning**— If you are burning leaves, a permit is required. Call 989.856.9198 for a burning permit and follow recorded instructions. Burning of leaves is allowed as long as weather conditions are acceptable, but burning of trash is not allowed pursuant to General Ordinance No: 2005-01.

#### RECYCLING

**Recycling** continues to be an issue at the Transfer Station. Our Transfer Station Attendant has advised us that many people are still not following the guidelines for recycling and are including items that should go in the trash and items not clean.

If anyone is willing to donate some of their time during recycling hours to help monitor the recycling drop off site, please contact the Township office. Many other communities were forced to discontinue their recycling programs because of abuse. Lake Township is one of the only townships in the area that still has a recycling program. We would like to keep it going!

Information on what can be recycled is available on the Township website or ask our Transfer Station Attendant. Bins are also available for \$10.00.
