Short Term Rentals

On September 18, 2023 the Lake Township Board adopted Ordinance No. 2023–02 amending the Lake Township Zoning Ordinance to define a "Short Term Rental" and clarify the guidelines for such uses. A Short Term Rental is defined as any dwelling rented for a period of less than 30 days. These uses are only allowed in the Township's Residential-Business (RB) and Business (B-1) Districts. All short term rental activity in any Residential District must end by December 31, 2024.

Recycling limit—two (2) green recycling containers.

Recycling should be clean and loose. Please do not drop off recyclables in garbage bags. There is no need to sort. A list of acceptable items is available at the Transfer Station or on the Township website.

Leaves, grass and tree trimmings are accepted at the Transfer Station during regular hours at no charge for composting as well as on Saturdays from 10-2 pm during the months of May and November. Saturdays are for composting only, no recycling or trash drop off.

The Lake Township Board of Trustees meets on the third Monday of the month. Winter meetings (December - March) begin at 6:30 P.M. April - November meetings at 7:30 P.M.

The Lake Township Planning Commission meets on the 4th Wednesday of the month at 6:00 PM except November and December. Check website for schedule.

Special meetings may be scheduled at other times. Notices are posted on the Township website and sent out by email upon request.
